LITURGY: OUR YEAR REVOLVES AROUND EASTER

Before the multiplication of calendars, the Church had the custom of proclaiming the date of Easter on the feast of Epiphany. We shall officially proclaim these dates to you today, but I thought you might like to see the dates.

The culmination of the year comes with the Sacred Easter Triduum which takes place from the fifth of April to the eighth of April.

Ash Wednesday, therefore, comes on the twenty-first of February;

The Ascension of the Lord comes on the twentieth of May;

Pentecost, which brings the joyful Easter season to a close, comes on the twenty-seventh of May;

The First Sunday of Advent comes on the second of December.

We also celebrate the mysteries of the Lord in the festivals of the Virgin Mary, and the other Saints.
