LITURGICAL NOTES

When I first learned how to use the Sacrament of Penance I learned to start by saying, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned." Now, however, the priest starts the conversation by welcoming the penitent. Then he makes the sign of the cross with the penitent and gives him or her a blessing. Then he reads a passage from the Bible. After that the penitent tells his sins. The priest offers advice or asks questions. Then he suggests a penance, or satisfaction. Once the penitent has accepted this, then he expresses his sorrow using his own words or an act of contrition he knows. Then the priest gives absolution. Last of all, the priest invites the penitent to give thanks to God. When the priest dismisses the penitent the penitent may answer, "Thanks be to God."

STEWARDSHIP
