We had some response to our request for the names of people possibly interested in priesthood or religious vocations. I appreciate your help. Siblings can often make observations that will steer a person into the vocation to which God has called that person. Adults and youth can contemplate God's call to the ordained ministry or the religious life.

LITURGICAL NOTES

What do we mean when we recite the creed and make a profession of faith. We all have a tendency to rush through prayers when we know the words by heart. Periodically I need to have someone tell me to slow down in ordinary speech. Sometimes we need reminders to slow down in our public praying. We believe in one God, a God of three divine Persons. We believe in the father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. We also believe in the one, holy, Catholic and apostolic Church. We need to take our time through the creed. The world has only one Church, which has the fullness of holiness, which traces its existence back to the Apostles and which embraces the whole world. We do not have a national church, but a Catholic one. Catholic means world-wide. When we slow down we can let what we profess make a bigger impact on us.

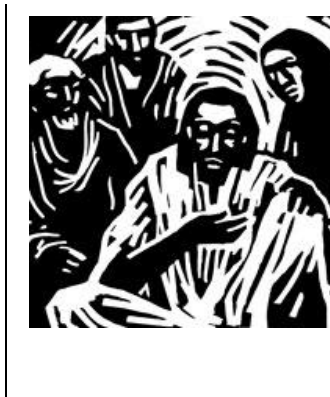
