#### FATHER DAVE and LENT

Physical fasting or giving up a bodily pleasure often creates a psychological hunger. This psychological hunger seeks satisfaction, often by making life harder for other people. This means that we tend to compensate for a physical hunger by filling a psychological void. When this happens we make other people suffer or put up with us. How we treat others has a greater importance than what food or pleasure we give up. We should use Lent to make life easier for others. We should make others feast because of our fast.

Fasting, eating less food, obliges those 18 to 59 on Good Friday. We recommend it also for Holy Saturday.

Abstaining from meat obliges all over 14 on the Fridays of Lent and on the fast days.

If your host graciously offers you meat, or have no choice, or if you order it by mistake, eat it gratefully.

## LITURGY

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, RCIA for short, calls us into Lent. It also guides us to understand Lent. It calls us all to renewal and conversion from sin. It tells us to look to the Easter Vigil and its emphasis on baptism as the true character of Lent.

At the Vigil we baptize those Chosen for Baptism and renew the baptismal commitment of the rest of us. Only the last days of Lent have any emphasis on the passion of the Lord. Lent ends at supper on Holy Thursday. From supper on we celebrate the Three Days of the Paschal Mystery that comes to a climax on Holy Saturday at the Easter Vigil.

The RCIA guides us this Lent. Today we send our catechumens to the Bishop who will rename them the Elect, those chosen for Baptism at the Easter Vigil. We send our candidates for full union with the Catholic Church to him and he will approve of their admission at the Easter Vigil. The RCIA challenges us to welcome newcomers and to imitate their examples of repentance and commitment.

Celebrate daily the Eucharist with us more during Lent. We have daily Mass at 8:00 a.m. most of the time. We have daily communion services before school at 6:30 a.m.

Celebrate the Sacrament of Penance during Lent.

Use the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary on Sundays.

### FIRST ARCHDIOCESAN ANNUAL FUND


Our annual Lenten fund drive for the archdiocese has several new elements. It asks for less money. It does not help fund the archdiocesan offices. It focuses on services.
