#### **FATHER DAVE**

The date of Easter depends on the first full month after the start of spring. It comes on the first Sunday after the first full moon of spring. This year the full moon comes on April 13.

The Second Sunday of Lent always comes a month before Holy Week. We always have a full moon during this week; it comes on Tuesday.

We always celebrate the transfiguration of Jesus on the Second Sunday of Lent. We do this for several reasons. The Church reminds us that Lent should transfigure us. We need this boost after having entered the desert of Lent last Sunday. Nature herself transfigures us and shares the beauty of a full moon with us.

#### LENT

Fasting, eating less food, obliges those 18 to 59 on Good Friday. We recommend it also for Holy Saturday.

Abstaining from meat obliges all over 14 on the Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday. We also recommend it on Holy Saturday.

If your host graciously offers you meat, or if you have no choice, or if you order it by mistake, eat it gratefully.
