FAIRER PAVE

This week we do the first of three scrutinies for the Elect. The first scrutiny examines or scrutinizes both the Elect and us. It asks that the Elect receive freedom from a sprit of deceit and gain a purity of heart as they advance to baptism. It forces us to look at ourselves, as the women at the well looked at herself. The Elect look to us for support and example. We gain from them as we notice their sincerity in preparing for baptism.

On Monday evening we shall present to the Elect the Creed. We shall expect them to learn it and give it back to us on Holy Saturday as they prepare for the Easter Vigil. We shall do this at Mass in the evening.

You probably noticed that we cancelled the 8:00 morning Mass on Monday. We did this for several reasons. I have a meeting overnight Sunday and Monday and cannot make the 8:00 Mass. I want to celebrate the most important saint of March, St Joseph, with you. I want to present the Creed to our Elect, those chosen for baptism. Mass on Monday evening at 7:00 suits these purposes well.

LENT

Fasting, eating less food, obliges those 18 to 59 on Good Friday. We recommend it also for Holy Saturday.

Abstaining from meat obliges all over 14 on the Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday. We also recommend it on Holy Saturday.

If your host graciously offers you meat, or if you have no choice, or if you order it by mistake, eat it gratefully.


