The RCIA forms us even as it forms the elect, those chosen for baptism at the Easter Vigil. I appreciated the many parishioners who came last Monday to help us present the Creed to our elect. On April 3, we shall have another evening Mass at 7:00, during which we shall present these elect with the Our Father.

We tend to take our weekly rituals and prayers for granted. Monday we recited the Creed in such a way that the elect could follow by hearing. We slowed the pace and listened to ourselves as we recited it. The elect learned and so did we. We dismissed the elect after the creed so that they could reflect on what they have heard. We also dismissed them because only the baptized have a right to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist. If we do not dismiss them on Sundays, we do not do it because we have no ready place to send them.

LENT

Fasting, eating less food, obliges those 18 to 59 on Good Friday. We recommend it also for Holy Saturday.

Abstaining from meat obliges all over 14 on the Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday. We also recommend it on Holy Saturday.

If your host graciously offers you meat, or if you have no choice, or if you order it by mistake, eat it gratefully.
