#### FAIRER DAVE

I have seen the results of the recent survey. I want to publish the results either this week or next in the form of an insert. Briefly I note that most everyone accepts that what we do in our programs reflects the will of God. On the practical level, 44% said that they would increase their donations. Hardly anybody wanted us to keep dipping into our reserves. Most everybody wanted us to cut programs to balance the budget.

How can I bridge the gap between a shortfall of \$70,000 and a balanced budget. Can I ask musicians and teacher to forego the modest stipend we offer them? I know musicians put in ten hours preparing for one Mass on Sunday. I know teacher put in at least two hours of preparation for each hour of class. Musicians form the backbone of our Sunday liturgy and enhance our prayer before God. Teachers form the heart of our religious education program. I feel like a guy flipping a two-headed coin while calling, "Tails."

# SILENCE IN THE LITURGY, PART 2

Somebody complained that we do not give people time to make their personal intentions at Mass. I shall plead guilty to that if by this you mean that we do not allow time for personal intentions during the petitions, or general intercessions, after the Creed.

I plead innocent otherwise because the time for making personal intentions comes before the Opening Prayer, also called the Collect. During the pause between the invitation to pray and the Collect Prayer, the priest should allow people time to make their own intentions. Then he collects these silent prayers of petition into the one spoken prayer called, for this reason, the Collect Prayer, or the Opening Prayer. It may help if I would remind you of that this weekend.


