FAIRER DAVE

Some have questions about the St Maron Catholic Church in Cleveland. One could not find it in the listing of the Catholic churches in Cleveland and wondered about it. St Maron gives his name to the Catholics of Lebanon, the only Christian state in the Middle East. The Lebanese Catholics, of all the Eastern Churches, has never left the Church of Rome by heresy or by schism.

The Maronite Catholic Church makes up one of the fourteen Eastern Catholic Churches that recognize the authority of the Pope. The Maronite Catholics have two dioceses, which they call eparchies, in the United States, the Eparchy of St Maron of Brooklyn and the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles.

Dayton has two Maronite parishes, St Ignatius of Antioch and Our Lady of Lebanon. Dayton also has a Ruthenian parish, St Barbara. All of these recognize the authority of the Pope and deserve the name Catholic.

THE LITURGY

"You may all sit down." I say this quite often. I suppose, if I explain why I say it, I should not have to say it so many times. As I understand the General Instruction for the Roman Missal, after all have received communion, two things should happen, everyone should sit down, and everyone should praise God in silence.

To help you sit down together, I try to say, "sit down." I should rather you sit down without having me tell you to sit down. On the other hand, you sit down together better as a group, when somebody gives you a signal to sit down, even though that communal act makes a loud noise.

The communion hymn accompanies the communion procession. It should end when the communion procession ends, leaving us to sit in silence as we praise God together. At times we may substitute a hymn of praise for part of the silent praise. The directives speak of a hymn of praise, not a meditation hymn; we do not meditate, but praise God after communion.

How did we ever get a meditation hymn? I think that someone who did not know Latin saw hymn of praise mentioned, and thought meditation hymn. The time for meditation comes after each of the readings or homily. The time between the communion procession and the Prayer after Communion provides for us to praise God silently or in song.

I shall happily give you a signal is to sit down, but I do not want to have to remind you to sit down. If I tell you to sit down, then understand that I only give you a signal to sit down. God bless you.
