I bring this to your attention to tell you that such a rumor has no foundation in truth. Our money in Cincinnati earns six (6) percent interest annually and will remain for our parishes.

I heard that we had over a hundred people sign up for New Beginnings so far. We still have room and we shall not turn you away if you want to come.

LITURGY: OTHER EASTERN CHURCHES

I wrote of the Eastern Catholic Churches last week. I made a point of calling them Catholic and emphasizing their allegiance to the Pope, the successor of St Peter. I did this because many other Eastern Churches do not consider the Pope as the visible head of the Church. For various reasons, mostly historical and political, they have gone their way independently of the Church of Rome; we call many of them Orthodox, but not catholic. They have the fullness of the sacraments, including Holy Orders and they celebrate the Eucharist validly.

Those in union with Rome we have often called Eastern Rites. The term Eastern Catholic Churches describes them better because they have fully developed hierarchies and sacraments. They also have unity with the whole Catholic Church. The Orthodox and other Eastern Churches have the hierarchy and sacraments, but not the union with the Pope.

EXPOSITION AND ADORATION

I have heard that at times we have no one in church during exposition. The Church does not allow us to have exposition with no one in church. If I find no one in, I have an obligation to put the Eucharist back into the tabernacle. The liturgy of exposition and reverence for the Eucharist require an honor guard before the Eucharist exposed for veneration. If you would like to get involved with exposition, please call the office so we can schedule you in.
