## LITURGY

We have to distinguish the Sacrament of the Sick from the Last Rites, or the sacraments for the dying. The Church means for the sick to receive the Anointing of the Sick, also called the Sacrament of the Sick, at the beginning of a serious illness, not at the end of the illness. It consecrates a person to the likeness of Christ who suffered. A person should receive the sacrament only once in a serious illness. When an emergency comes suddenly upon a person, he or she should receive the sacrament at that time.

For the dying person we have the last Rites, the Eucharist, celebrated as Viaticum, food for the journey through death. The last Rites includes the Sacrament of Penance, a special blessing given by the priest in the name of the Pope, Communion and special prayers for the dying. As a norm, the Sacrament of the Sick does not for part of the Last Rites.

Once a person has died he or she cannot receive any sacraments. The priest can pray over the body, but does not give it a sacrament.

Please call the office at the beginning of a serious illness or when going into the hospital so that we can tend to your spiritual needs.

## OCTOBER COUNT
