I know of one who died of emphysema, caused by smoking. I know that God has called us to holiness despite our faults and imperfections; his grace works best with our weakness.

I feel at home at St Denis and Holy Family Churches. The people and priests of Visitation Church in Eaton made me welcome. I thank them for this and love them. Nonetheless, I prefer home to away. I thank you for welcoming me and pray for you. I love all of you.

I have done two hard things in my life. I presided over the funeral of a parish. I would not want to inflict this ordeal on anyone and do to want to do it again. Closing a parish seems very much like burying a spouse.

I have had to leave you and go into exile. This to me seemed very much like a divorce. I would not wish this on anyone. Coming back seems like reconciliation. I can understand, however, how some members of the family, especially might find the reconciliation hard to take. Since we all suffer from imperfection, I want to move on to serve God here with you.

R.C.I.A. PROGRAM


