The person does this either by marrying before a priest of deacon or by obtaining permission from the archbishop to marry before someone else.

Although a bride and groom tend to look upon the ceremony in which they marry as their ceremony, it properly belongs to the Church. The ceremony involves public worship of God, liturgy. The act of mutually pledging their bodies with all their fertility to one another gives worship and praise to God. All those present join in praising God with them.


