My nephew appreciated having me come to baptize his daughter. I enjoyed going out. Every time I go someplace for Mass I come home appreciating my home parishes more. Much as I liked celebrating Mass for my nephew's parishioners, I enjoy celebrating here more. My nephew goes to a small church that seats about 60 people. I counted about 40 people in two Masses. The collection the week before came to \$900 for the parish and \$300 for the retired religious, not bad for a small parish. I counted two babies and six other children. Some probably could not make it because of the weather. (At one time the people of the area received permission from the Pope to celebrate Christmas on July 25, when they could travel the roads better. The road above my nephew's place closes for the winter.) I enjoyed the people there and they enjoyed me, but I enjoy you of Holy Family and St Denis better.

The Penitential Rite prepares us to listen to the Word of God and celebrate the Eucharist. When other rites do the same thing we do not repeat the Penitential Rite.
