Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. In the Ascension the Lord Jesus climbs up to heaven; he takes the initiative. He takes his place at the Father's side as his equal. In August we celebrate the Assumption of Mary, the Mother of God, into heaven. Mary does not climb into heaven, but God takes her up into heaven; God takes the initiative and Mary receives. The use of the term Ascension affirms the Lord Jesus as God. The use of the term Assumption affirms Mary as one of us. The term Ascension affirms Jesus as the God-Man, while the term Assumption affirms Mary's created status.

We use the RCIA process for non-baptized children in school.


BLESSING OF RELIGIOUS ARTICLES
