LITURGY: SPRINKLING RITE

The Church celebrates the paschal mystery on the first day of the week, the Lord's Day or Sunday. Because we enter into the paschal mystery in the bath of baptism, the Church has provided a ceremony for blessing and sprinkling holy water for use on Sundays in all churches and chapels. On Sundays, when we celebrate the Easter mystery in a special way, we may bless water to remind us of our baptism and ask God to keep us faithful to the covenant of baptism. Since the whole Easter season celebrates the Easter mystery in a special way, the Church has recommended that we use the sprinkling rite every Sunday during Easter. When we do not bless water and do the sprinkling rite, we recommend the use of holy water as you come into the church building to remind you that you have entered the Church through the waters of baptism.

DAUGHTERS OF ISABELLA


