LITURGY: PURIFICATION

A parishioner has observed me purifying the sacred vessels after communion. He has two questions, why we call it purifying and why have I started doing it on the side of the altar and not in the center. I can answer the second question more easily than the first. We try to do the rinsing of the cups on the side because the action does not have central importance. We have to rinse them out either after communion or after Mass. We consider rinsing the vessels a necessary chore, but not a central one. As for calling the action purification, perhaps I have answered the question by speaking of rinsing. Purifying seems to imply cleaning something dirty, whereas we rinse to protect the Eucharist from contamination.


