Someone asked about candles. To put it simply, we may use from two to six candles at Mass, not counting the Easter Candle. I use candles to help indicate the solemnity of the celebration. I try to use six candles on the most important feasts and on all Sundays. I try to use four candles on feasts of lesser rank and during the Easter season. I try to use only two candles on weekdays and memorials of saints. If this does not always work out, it does not bother me.


## **ROSARY BEFORE MASS**
