SEPTIC SYSTEM

I found out that the recent ruling on septic systems does not apply to us because the EPA considers us commercial, not residential. I found out from with Mr. Michael Bruns of Motes and Associates that the clayey soil of the church will not allow us to put in anything other than an above-ground system and that the EPA will not allow a holding tank that a commercial outfit would empty periodically. I asked him about the allegedly failure of an above-ground system in North Star, but I have not heard from him on this.

I have sent out for bids for the project and expect to have them back by the end of August.

The other five share the same name as the Mother of God, but did not the same privileges.


BETHLEHEM CHRISTIAN FAMILES


FATIMA USA 2007


