OCTOBER COUNT 2007

The average attendance at Mass this past month showed a smaller attendance at all Masses but one. The 9:30 Mass showed an increase of 17, rising to 223. The totals for the other Masses showed a decline of 75, from 1049 to 974. In general we had larger congregations in the first half of the month.

FATHER DAVE

What happens after the survey? I spoke with the Office of Development for the Archdiocese last week and learned this. Ninety-five percent of the parishes listed learning more about Catholic Social Services than any other program in the archdiocese. The Office of Development will organize ninety-minute workshops on the six areas for December and January in nearby parishes. I offered our parishes for one on Catholic Social Services. I shall give you more information when I hear of it.

The archbishop actually dedicated the Cathedral on November 2. In that year, since November 2 fell on a Sunday, the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed had to move to November 3. Nowadays we never move the celebration of All Souls Day. As a result we permanently celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral on November 3. The year marks the fiftieth anniversary of the rededication of the cathedral under Archbishop Alter after it had undergone extensive renovation and extension.
