#### FATHER DAVE

Since the Second Vatican Council, the Church has encouraged us to pray and work with other Christian and religious groups in ways that we can. We cannot celebrate Eucharist together, but we can join in praising and thanking God in other prayers. This praying and working together will hasten the day when we Christians can gather around one altar and praise God together in his one Church.

We have two opportunities to engage in ecumenical activities this week. At Trinity Lutheran Church on Wednesday, we serve the Community Supper from 5:00 to 6:30. Our team will prepare a Thanksgiving supper for the community.

Afterwards, I encourage you to take part in the annual ecumenical Thanksgiving prayer service. This year, it will take place at the St Paul Lutheran Church in Willowdell, at 7:30 this coming Wednesday, after supper.

We have an additional opportunity, preparing food for the St Vincent de Paul Shelter in Dayton. We ask you to take from the exits of church a pan, a lid and a sheet of recipes and prepare a meal according to directions. The St Ann Sodality will deliver the food the first week of December.

#### **LITURGY**

Christ the Lord received a gift from the Father. He passed this gift on to the Apostles alone when he said, "All power in heaven and earth has been given to me, going, therefore, teach all nations." He also wanted the college of the Apostles especially to have unity in two ways, intrinsically by faith and love and extrinsically by the ruler of one over all. To this end he made Peter chief of the Apostles as a perpetual source of unity and the visible foundation of unity.

This thought comes from Pope Pius XI, in his encyclical letter, Ecclesiam Dei, of 1923 (AAS XV, 573). He then goes on to praise St Josaphat who died in 1623, giving his life to bring the Orthodox into union with the Catholic Church.
