LITURGY

I have the task of preparing the homily each week. The homily attempts to open the Scriptures proclaimed so that we can feed on them. The pause after the spoken part of the homily should allow time to apply the Scriptures to ourselves.

The fathers of the Second Vatican Council, responding to a thirst of Catholics for more of the Bible, established a three-year cycle of readings with three readings each Sunday. Next Sunday, we return to Cycle A. I propose to base my Sunday homilies for the next three years on the Old Testament readings. These readings, the first of our readings, ties in best with the gospel reading, but these readings have a value in their own rite, which I want to explore in the homily. I do not want to make the homily Bible Study, but I do want to open us up to more of the Sacred Scriptures.
