FATHER DAVE

Many ask about missing Mass after a major snowstorm, such as happened last week. You do not need to put yourself, your family or others in jeopardy by traveling roads made dangerous by ice and snow. If you cannot get to Mass, you do not have to come to Mass. If you cannot come to Mass, gather the family and read the Scriptures for the day and pray together. If you discuss the Scriptures at home both the older and the younger will have something positive to contribute to the experience of prayer. This will help the family prepare to attend the liturgy the next weekend. Many people have told me that they feel guilty about missing Mass on such occasions. I can appreciate the guilt feelings. I should have them also if I should miss Mass, but these feelings would flow from my disappointment, not from sin.

We should not equate guilt feelings with guilt. Guilt does not necessarily make us feel guilty. Disappointment and other factors can make us feel guilty when we have no guilt.

LITURGY

The liturgy at Christmas gradually unfolds the mystery of the incarnation. The vigil celebrates the human ancestry of Jesus. The Mass at Night celebrates the birth of Jesus using Luke's account. The Mass at Dawn celebrates what this birth means for the poor of the world. The Mass at Day celebrates how the Word of God, which existed from before time, entered time as the Word of God became flesh and made his dwelling among us.

We decorate for Christmas after the last Mass of Advent. This year we shall decorate on Monday, December 24, at 9:00 unless we have a funeral, in which case, we shall do it at 1:00 p.m.
