I had a good time in New Mexico. My nephew and his wife provided mountains of food, the use of a car, places to go and a baby to baptize. We visited the zoo, botanical gardens and the aquarium with both his children, one in a stroller and one walking. We went to Santa Fe to see the Loretto Chapel with its staircase, St Miguel Church, the oldest church in continuous use in the United States, and the cathedral.

The older great-niece made sure that she let each of us spend time with her on these trips. She would walk awhile with one person, then switch to another until she had walked with both sets of grandparents, both parents, her great-uncle and her baby sister, very good for a two-year old. Both sets of grandparents took turns take care of the children without fighting. I chose the job of pushing the stroller many times. Daily Mass brought us together, usually at the monastery where the pastor lived.

LITURGY

The bishops of the United States have issued a new instruction on singing in the liturgy. Among other things, it says that the priests celebrant should not sing or say the Memorial Acclamation of the Amen at the end of the Eucharistic Prayer. This means that I have to learn not to sing the acclamation with you. If you see me not singing, know that I do so because I do not want to take your part away from you.


