
FATHER DAVE

LITURGY

Next week we shall change the route for receiving communion at St Denis. After much reflection and having considered the recommendation of the Worship Commission and having passed its decision through the Pastoral Council, I have decided to move the station in the back of church to the front of church and have three stations in the front and center and one near the door to the parking lot. This will enable all who receive communion to process up to communion and avoids the anomaly of having people move away from the altar to receive.

This means that the two lines moving up the main aisle would split into three at the head of the aisle to approach the distributors who have placed themselves so that people can receive from the plate and then approach the cup easily.


