LITURGY

Those distributing communion will have better communications with each other, especially towards the end of communion when one distributor has more than enough and another has too few hosts left. Distributors will have easier access to their stations. The ushers should find it easier to direct traffic.

I can see several disadvantages. It takes time to get used to a change. Those who move with some difficulty will have to move to a different section for the same closeness to communion. They will have the advantage of padded cushions if they move to the area in front of the tabernacle.

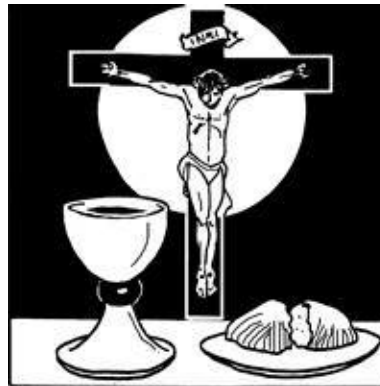
