FATHER DAVE

In 1964, Pope Paul VI canonized Charles Lwanga, Matthew Molumba Kalemba and their nineteen companions as martyrs of Uganda. They died because they professed their faith in Christ and resisted unjust practices by the king. In his homily at the Mass of canonization, Pope Paul compared them with other African martyrs from the time before St Augustine, also a saint from Africa. The Pope said, "also worthy of mention are others who, professing the Anglican religion, suffered death for the name of Christ." Among these Anglicans, we can name James Hannington, Anglican Bishop of Equatorial Africa, who died October 29, 1885. We celebrated St Charles Lwanga and his companions last Tuesday, June 3.

LITURGY

We have entered something we call Ordinary Time. The Latin text uses "through the year" for this time. The English uses Ordinary Time. I consider ordinary are very extraordinary word in the context of liturgy. We count only bishops, priests and deacons as ordinary ministers of Communion because they have received the sacrament of holy orders. We speak of ordinary time as time ranked by ordinal numbers, first, second, third and so on. Time ranked by ordinal number counts the thirty-three or thirty-four weeks when we do not celebrate Easter, Christmas, Lent or Advent. This time marked by the ordinals does not mean a time of no importance or a time when nothing extraordinary happens. Rather, it denotes a time of celebrating the wholeness of Christ and his saving mysteries, a matter of great importance.

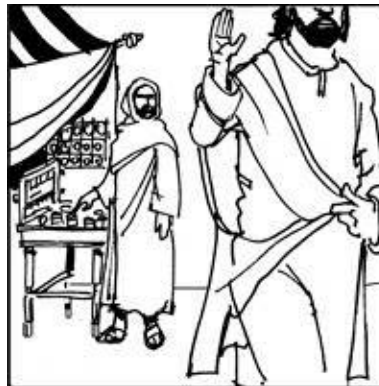
PICTORIAL DIRECTORIES and COLLECTION ENVELOPES
