FATHER DAVE

Next weekend we celebrate the feast of Sts Peter and Paul. The feast replaces the Thirteenth Sunday. It also has two sets of readings, one for Saturday evening and one for the celebrations of Sunday morning. I have tried to alert the lectors above, but I can remind them now.

On this last week of June, we always take up a collection for the Pope. We send the whole collection next week to the pope. As usual, we shall exclude items clearly marked for the parish.

Next week, Father Glen Perin will take my place at the 11:00 Mass. I shall stay over at Holy Family for the parish meeting.

LITURGY

The Office of Readings of the Liturgy of the Hours for today speaks of Christ as king and priest forever. It touches on the homily of last week when I spoke of the priesthood of the baptized. The reading comes from Faustinus Luciferan's work *On the Trinity* which he wrote about the year 380.

Our savior is truly Christ in the flesh, truly a king and truly a priest, both together so that no one should look down upon him. Psalm 2 says, "I have been set up as king over Sion, his holy mountain" and psalm 110 says, "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchisedek." His priesthood does not come from Aaron, a priesthood by succession, but from Melchisedek, a priest forever. He is savior and king and priest according to the flesh, but with an anointing of the Spirit. Kings and priests received a bodily anointing with oil. Christ has his priesthood and kingdom in a perfect way that fulfills the law.

The author goes on to explain this in more detail, but he establishes the fact of Christ as priest and king. Baptism then establishes us into Christ, our priest and king. Baptism then makes us priests and royalty in Christ.

Because of what baptism does to the individual, those who have received baptism can join in the offering of the Eucharist. Even baptized babies, sometimes sleeping and sometimes crying, join in offering the Eucharist.

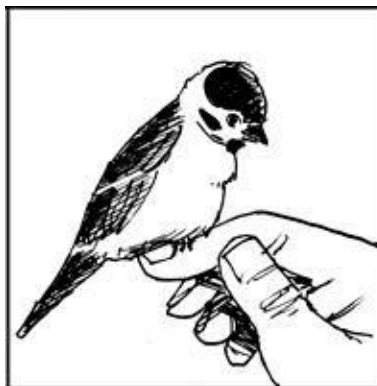
PICTORIAL DIRECTORIES and COLLECTION ENVELOPES
