
#### **COMMUNITY VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL**

#### **VATICAN EXHIBIT IN CLEVELAND**

The Mandylion of Edessa dates from the third to fifth century. It gives us the earliest known image of the face of Christ. One legend has it that no human hand painted the image. Another says that one Ananias painted it during the lifetime of Jesus for King Abgar V, of Edessa with the help of the Apostle Thaddeus. The Mandylion has a very dark picture of Christ, one hard to copy, but I think that Dee Printing did an excellent job copying it for the bulletin last week. The word mandylion means holy towel.
