LITURGY

Missionaries go forth in the name of the Church, both the local church and universal church. When possible, the church sends them forth from Mass. Jessica Krueger will leave us in August to spend twelve months to a year and a half in Bangkok, Thailand. She will join three other Catholic missionaries from Hearts Home, an international Catholic movement with branches in the Brooklyn and New York dioceses. She will go to live presence to the love of God for children and women forced into prostitution.

She will join us at the 5:00 Mass for a missionary's send-off. She asks your prayers and financial support for her. It costs \$650 a month to keep her in Thailand. In the Acts of the Apostles, 13:2-3, we read how the early church sent Paul and Barnabas on the first missionary journey of the Church. We shall do this with Jessica August 16. We shall have more information in the coming weeks.
