**FATHER DAVE**

Slow down. Periodically some has to remind me to slow down. I have a tendency to run my words together. This goes back to childhood. I have had to watch myself so that I speak clearly.

As a congregation, we have a tendency to let the momentum of the group speed us up in our praying. Periodically, I feel I have to remind us to slow down in our group recitations, such as the Creed and acclamations. When we recite from rote, we tend to recite quickly. We need to take time in our group praying so that we can reflect on the words. We say words to convey meaning. If we do not reflect on the meaning of what we say, we risk merely mouthing words. We all need to slow down.

**LITURGY**

We often assume that people understand what our feasts and celebrations mean. This week we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of Mary. Many of our children do not understand this feast because it always comes when we do not have CCD, in the summer. On the other hand, you, their parents have the primary responsibility of training them in the practice of the faith. The assumption of Mary means that at the end of her life on earth, the Lord Jesus took her, body and soul, to himself, just as he will take us, body and soul, at the end of the world. We celebrate this as a holyday of obligation, which means that we celebrate it as a Sunday, because of the important for us of our belief in the resurrection of the body. We celebrate this feast with a Mass on the eve, Thursday, at 6:30. We continue the celebration Friday with Masses at 6:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. at St Denis and at 7:30 p.m. at Holy Family.
