LITURGY

Periodically I get questions about posture in church. Posture ought to make the celebration beautiful in its simplicity. Common postures reflect our community. Standing seems the default posture at Mass; we stand unless we sit or kneel. When we do not stand, we sit. When we do not stand or sit, we kneel.

We sit during the readings before the gospel, during the Preparation of the Gifts and, by preference, after Communion during the silent praise of God. We only kneel from the end of the Holy, Holy to the Amen of the Eucharistic Prayer and after the Lamb of God. We stand the rest of the time.


FUNERAL LUNCHEONS
