Name the liturgical colors. We use six colors in the Church, red, green, white, violet, black and rose. Black, which we used to use for all Masses for the dead, remains an option, together with violet and white, for funerals. On the third Sunday of Advent and the fourth Sunday of lent, we may use rose vestments. The color rose tones down the usual violet of Advent and Lent. Rose looks violet when placed beside red and looks red when placed beside violet.
