Last Monday's feast of the Presentation of the Lord marked the fortieth day after Christmas and the midpoint of winter. The groundhog has nothing to do with it. In the mystery of the presentation, Christ takes possession of his Father's house and temple. He wants to take possession of our temple and change our winter into spring.

LITURGY AND BOOKS

Liturgy needs things of substance. What we use should use books that proclaim by their appearance the importance of liturgy for us. We have good books for the prayers and readings done by the priest, deacon and lectors. We do not have, however, substantial books for our singing. We have better books now than we had several years ago when we used a seasonal worship aid. Then we had the liturgy printed on newsprint, which we discarded on a regular basis. We graduated to a yearly publication, still on newsprint, but discarded annually. Every year the publishers change the ordering of the hymns and the hymn numbers so that our musicians have to search diligently to match the numbers in the hymnal with their instrumental copies. The liturgy deserves better than this. Newsprint declares cheapness. Books designed to last only a short time proclaim that we can throw away God's word and the Church's prayers the way we throw out the daily newspaper. The Word of God remains forever, but our current hymnal only remains a year. Our musicians want to adopt the hardbound hymnal, such as Gather by GIA. This will give us a greater variety of hymns and a book that should last many years, such as the liturgy deserves. We have made no decision to change, but we want you to know the thinking we have on this.


