**FATHER DAVE**

I hate to take off during Lent. My sister, however, has made an "offer I cannot refuse", so I shall spend some time with her this week. I expect to return for Mass on Wednesday. The following week, I shall go on retreat with many other priests of the archdiocese from Monday through Friday. Then I hope to stay put for the rest of Lent.

**LITURGY AND COMMUNION**

The *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, the document that guides the celebration of Mass, instructs us that "it is most desirable that the faithful, just as the priest himself is bound to do, receive the Lord's Body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass (#85). In this it echoes the first document of the Second Vatican Council, the *Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy*, #31. The documents also recommend that the priest use altar bread large enough so that at least a few of the faithful may share from his portion.

We have used a larger altar bread for years, one that breaks readily into twenty-four pieces. I have often felt self-conscious about sharing with only a few, so I have searched for a way of sharing the one bread with everyone. I have consulted the Worship Commission and have decided to try using only the larger altar breads at Mass. This will allow all to receive of the one bread broken for all. It will also take longer to divide the Eucharistic bread into containers for the distributors. This means that we can expect the Lamb of God to continue until we have all the Eucharistic bread broken and ready for distribution. Please bear with us in this change.
