FATHER DAVE

Wow. You have done well. You have made the goals of both parishes in the Catholic Ministries Appeal. One has given 175 % of the goal and the other parish has had more participation, but you both made your goals. Congratulations.

Next weekend, we take up the annual collection for Catholic Relief. This collection helps resettle refugees and serves victims of human trafficking. Catholic Relief Services helped nearly one third of those authorized to enter the United States last year. Please continue your generosity in this collection. The entire collection, except what we can readily identify for the parishes will go to this cause.

LITURGY AND COMMUNION

We use the word excommunication of those not allowed to receive communion. This describes such people as separated and cut off from the body of Christ. Those allowed to share in communion have membership in the body of Christ. When they receive communion and share in the Eucharist, they have union with each of us in Christ. In the Eucharist, we have union with all believers and with Christ. Without the union with each other, we have no union with Christ. We should not ask the Lord, "Come to me." Rather we should thank him for coming to all of us. Welcoming children to first communion resembles welcoming children to the family table when they graduate from the high chair: both involve the whole family.
