LITURGY AND FIRST COMMUNION

While I recognize that reception of first communion involves the family of the communicant, it involves more profoundly and deeply the Church. Communion brings each of us into the mystery of the Church. We do not meet Christ, except in the Church. Communion means sharing in the sacrament of the Eucharist. We do not meet Christ in any sacrament apart from the Church. We meet Christ with other believers and we see all believers as Christ.

I have heard some concern that sometimes our pictures of our first communicants as they receive communion may show non-family members in the background. Our photographer tries to focus on each child and does a good job with this. Sometimes part of another person will make its way into a photo, but we cannot call other people strangers since we all make up the one family of God, united in the body of Christ that we celebrate at communion. All of our relatives, those by faith, as well as those by blood and marriage, have a right to share the joy of the Church over the first communion of its members.
