It makes sense, therefore, to bless these things when the people who will use them can come. For this reason, I shall happily bless all religious articles this week if you bring them to CCD on Monday and Wednesday.

LITURGY AND FIRST COMMUNION

Some one asked me this. If Christmas celebrates God the Father and Easter, Cod the Son and Pentecost, God the Holy Spirit, why do we not celebrate Pentecost more? Perhaps these three feasts emphasize one Person of God over the other two, nonetheless, all three persons have an equal hand in each mystery. The Virgin Mary conceives through the action of the Holy Spirit. In his resurrection, the Lord Jesus sends upon us the Holy Spirit. We cannot separate the first day of the Easter celebration, the resurrection, from the last day of this celebration, the giving of the Holy Spirit.

All throughout the Easter season, we experience the resurrection of the Lord and the giving of the Holy Spirit. We constantly read from the Acts of the Apostles, which tells of the action of Holy Spirit in the Church. We have constant reminders of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus in the readings and prayers of the Church for this season. Easter and Pentecost make up the two sides of the same coin, the coin of the resurrection and glorification of the Lord Jesus. The fullness of this mystery has such a vastness that we need one-seventh of the year and one-seventh of every week to celebrate it


