FATHER DAVE

Originally. we celebrated Memorial Day on May 30. At one time, the archbishop ordained priests on the last Saturday of May. So, it came about that he ordained class of 1964 on Memorial Day itself. I still feel like celebrating Memorial Day on the thirtieth, but I gladly celebrate it on the last full weekend of May. By God's grace I have celebrated forty-five years of ordained priesthood. My classmates and I met last Wednesday to celebrate with a meal in Cincinnati.

LITURGY

Next week we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. At one time, we celebrated the two aspects of the eucharist separately, the Body on next Sunday's feast and the Blood on July 1, but now we celebrate them together. We do need both the Body and the Blood for the whole eucharist.

The feast makes us focus on the reality of Christ's presence, both under the form of bread and under the form of wine. The fullness of Christ's person exists under each form, but the reception of the eucharist gives us a fuller experience of the fullness of the Lord's real presence both under the form of bred and under the form of wine.

We should guard each fragment and drop of the eucharist. We do not brush off crumbs of the eucharist as we would crumbs from food at home, but we reverently consume them, if at all possible. The priest tries to safeguard crumbs he sees. You can do the same. If you see a small piece of the eucharist in your hand, moisten the tip of your finger and reverently put this in your mouth.


