Welcome, all visitors to Poultry Days. I enjoy your presence. In no other place that I have served have I have observed such courtesy and good behavior as I have consistently seen in you.

LITURGY

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord. This feast celebrates both the Body of Christ and the Blood of Christ. At one time, we celebrated the Body of Christ today and, on July 1, the Blood of Christ. We Catholics believe that, through the action of the Holy Spirit God changes the bread and the wine into the real body and the real blood of Christ.

The readings today emphasize the blood of Christ. This can remind us that Christ said to eat and drink. The Church encourages us to receive communion under both forms, not because we receive more, but because we have a fuller sign of the banquet of the eucharist. In our other meals, our solid food contains some liquid and our beverages have some solid material, but we eat and drink anyway. In the banquet of the eucharist, in like manner, although we have the whole Christ under each form, we should eat and drink at communion.

We should make a reverence before receiving communion. In the United States, our bishops have decided that the proper reverence should consist of a simple bowing of the head.
