He does not want to separate us, the body, from our head, but he wants to impress upon us that we must radiate to others the things that Christ stands for. The world has no Christ but one. He has ascended into heaven and the world no longer sees him except through us, his body. He has made us the other [form of] Christ, the manifestation of Christ that the world can see.

Later spiritual writers have spoken of the ordained priest as the other Christ, but this title more properly belongs to every Christian. All of us, priest, deacon or lay person must show the power of God, the wisdom of God, the light of God, the image of God and true faith in God, all that the Lord Jesus did while among us in the flesh.

New offering envelopes are available for St. Denis members in the back of church. The new envelopes begin the first Sunday in July and you can save the parish postage by picking up your box. Thank you.

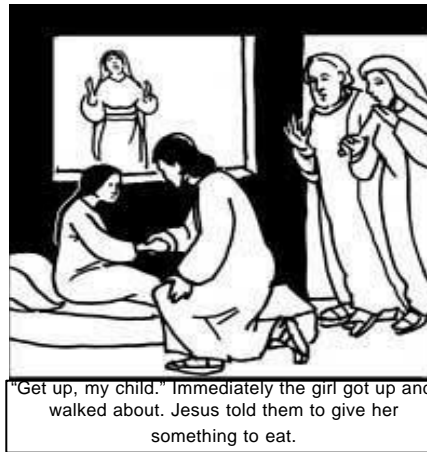
**R.C.I.A. PROGRAM**
