**LITURGY**

What do we venerate during Mass? Oops, I gave you a trick question. During Mass, we reverence the altar, not the tabernacle. Before Mass and after Mass, we venerate the Lord's presence in the tabernacle, if the tabernacle stands near the altar as at Holy Family Church. During Mass, even prior to the Second Vatican Council, we venerated the tabernacle only at the beginning and end of Mass. Once Mass begins, we should focus on the altar as the center of Christ's action among us. The altar represents Christ. If you notice the priest bowing towards the altar at the start and end of Mass, know that by so doing, he reverences a powerful symbol of Christ.
