FATHER DAVE

Last winter I had surgery on my left eye to repair a pucker in the macula. I went to a retina specialist. Often in cases like this, a cataract develops. In mine it did. This Thursday I have it removed. This requires simple surgery, but the choice of lens involves greater complexity. Besides fixed lenses, the doctor also offers choices that can almost duplicate the normal lens.

LITURGY: LAST RITES

I want to keep the distinction between the sacrament of the sick and last rites. We celebrate the sacrament of the sick at the start of a serious illness. We celebrate the last rites shortly before a person dies. The sacrament of the sick prays for healing; the last rites pray for a happy death. When David Coons had his accident, we celebrated the sacrament of the sick in the intensive care unit. This past week I saw him on his way to his grandparents' fiftieth wedding anniversary party. We did not celebrate the last rites for him.
