We must mention our bishop and we have the option of mentioning his auxiliary. Archbishop Pilarczyk remains our archbishop until the Pope accepts his resignation or he dies. As soon as one of these happens, Archbishop Schnurr will step into his shoes as the Archbishop of Cincinnati.

I personally do not think the Pope will accept his resignation until after he celebrates the fiftieth anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood and the thirty-fifth of his ordination as a bishop, both of which take place December 20 of this year.
