GETTING MARRIED?

For a Catholic to marry someone validly in the Catholic Church, the person must marry before a priest or deacon and two witnesses, unless the Bishop grants a dispensation. Fulfilling only the civil requirements does not make a couple validly married. Those divorced need have their previous marriages proven invalid, null and void, by the Church. Validly means a sacramental marriage if both parties have received baptism. Contact the office for more information.

FATHER DAVE

Our Ohio bishops gathered every active priest to Columbus for a two-day meeting on marriage. I know the bishops have a pastoral letter in preparation and we may hear something about this, but I do not know for sure and I shall not know until after we shall have sent this bulletin to the printer. Besides the information on marriage, we should have a good time meeting all the other priests of Ohio, classmates and friends.

LITURGY: COMMUNION AND REAL PRESENCE

Christ's real presence exists in each and every fragment of the consecrated bread and wine. I, therefore, have a concern when people tell me that they have found fragments of the Body of Christ in church after Mass. For my part, I shall take greater care in breaking the consecrated bread. I now break the bread into quarters before Mass so that I can make a cleaner and easier break during the Lamb of God.

Our musicians try to lead us in singing the Lamb of God. This lasts as long as it takes the priest to break the consecrated bread and only then does the singing end. When we sing the Lamb of God during the entire breaking of the bread, I can do my job without undue hurry or haste.

Please consume the Eucharist before you go back to your places. If you notice any fragments in your hand, please consume them reverently.
