FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

I said to myself and to a few others last week, that I thought our two parishes would give at least \$14,000 for the relief of Haiti and you did it. I suppose I should have said more, but I did not. You can still give. If we receive a little less than six thousand more, we shall have given twenty thousand dollars.

LITURGY: BAPTISM

I recently received a call to baptize a newborn in the hospital. Had the child died or not I had to decide. Yes, the doctors said he had died, but I could see the possibility of doubt from previous experiences. As a result, I chose to baptize the child conditionally. Conditionally means that if the child has not yet died, I baptize him, but if he has already died, I do not baptize him. We can only celebrate the sacraments with living people. At death, we pass beyond sacraments to see the Lord face to face.

Later I found myself in a discussion with older cousins. We talked about who can baptize. All the faithful can; it does not take a deacon, priest or bishop to baptize. Anyone can baptize. Pastor Falk at Trinity Lutheran and the other ministers in town do baptize. Average Catholics can also baptize, though normally they do so only in emergencies.

To baptize, use ordinary water, intend to baptize and say while pouring the water, "I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
