STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

We have made a commitment to enhance our stewardship of treasure. In gratitude to you and those who have gone before you, we want to strengthen our giving to the parish. In this way, we hope to preserve what we have and pass it on to the next generations. We would not have anything to enhance if you had not given so generously in the past.

We have started taking steps to provide greater security for what you give in the offertory collection. This does not mean that we have had problems with the security, but that we can see ways of improving the integrity of what you give.

St Denis will need another \$30,000 per year to offset the revenue we used to receive from the school system. Both parishes can expect repairs on their buildings in the next five to ten years. Costs have risen in the parishes, just as they have risen in our homes. How we respond to this stewardship program will tell us what impact we shall have on the future needs and growth of the parish.

FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN:

Today, on Respect Life Sunday, we pay attention to issues about life. Respecting life includes concern for abortion, the death penalty, where we allow sex-offenders to live, divine mercy, end-of-life care, infertility treatments in line with Church teaching, sexual trafficking, population control, depression and suicide among youth and the promise of pro-life youth among other things.

LITURGY

Does the priest say Mass? We no longer speak of saying. For a priest to say Mass can imply that no one else need get involved and that it all depends on the priest. The Church, however, teaches that the Mass involves the whole community with the priest presiding over the assembled congregation. The whole assembled community takes part in the celebration. Christ joins all of us together through the priest who acts with a special mandate from Christ (the meaning of "in the person of Christ").

The Church earnestly wants us to understand this, because this forms the basis for full, conscious and active participation desired by the Second Vatican Council. If we do not understand this, then we can justify leaving early and not participating at Mass.
