FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN:

¿Habla espagnol? Four priests have started gathering every Wednesday for a session lasting an hour and a half of pastoral Spanish. Spanish has more letters than English. The ch, ll, ñ, and rr add to the count of the letters. Baptism in English turns into bautismo in Spanish, the ut replacing the pt.

Three of us studied French in high school and college and we often revert back to our first modern foreign language instead of Latin. "Me too" sometimes sounds like "moi aussi" (French) than "me tambien" (Spanish).

Just as we had French-speaking priests ministering to our immigrant ancestors here, so now we need Spanish-speaking priests for a new influx of immigrants. Pray for us.

LITURGY

In fourteen months, we shall change some of the translations we use at Mass. When we first used English in the liturgy, we had no idea that our English would form the basis for translation for many languages and peoples. Now we see English used as once we used Latin, as a universal language. This provides good reason to make sure we have very accurate translations; it ensures that we all have the same vocabulary in our languages to profess the one faith we believe.

WORKSHOP ON THE LITURGY



We do not allow students to leave the church property to go any place before CCD once they have set foot on the property. At this moment, legally, we have to assume responsibility. Please instruct your children not to leave the premises once they have arrived. If you allow them to go some place else, please have them go before they enter the church property. We will not give permission for any child to leave the property; we do not want the liability or responsibility for them off the property.

Our policy forbids any food or drink in the classrooms during CCD. Students must have consumed all food and drink before entering the classrooms or the school building. WHY HAVE A STEWARDSHIP INITIATIVE: This is an archdiocesanwide stewardship program and will be given in all parishes of the Cincinnati Archdiocese. The Archdiocese is covering the expense of the program.

WHY NOW: St Denis will need another \$30,000 per year to offset the revenue we used to receive from the school system. Both parishes can expect repairs on their buildings in the next five to ten years. Costs have risen in the parishes, just as they have risen in our homes. How we respond to this stewardship program will tell us what impact we shall have on the future needs and growth of the parish.
