LITURGY: EASTER

It takes fifty days to celebrate the mystery of Easter, a week of weeks a Sunday. This present week, the Church observes as a week of Sundays and we call the days Easter Monday, Easter Tuesday and so on.

Easter celebrates the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, our resurrection with him in baptism and the growth of the Church. Pentecost and Easter make up the two sides of the one coin of Easter. Both celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit by the resurrected Lord Jesus.
