

LITURGY: THE MYSTERIOUS SEVEN

These comments flow from the second reading for today. Countless living creatures and elders praise the Lamb, once slain, who lives forever and ever. They offer him seven praises, power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing. The seven indicate perfection.

Seven corresponds to the number of petitions in the Our Father, the number of sacraments, the number of gifts of the Holy Spirit, the number of weeks of Easter. In all these, the number seven indicates not absolute value seven. In the seven praises, we have perfect praise. In seven petitions, we have the perfect request. In the seven sacraments, we have the fullness of Christ's perfection among us. In the seven gifts, we have the totality of the myriad of gifts. In the weeks of Easter, we have the fullness of the Risen Lord's presence and giving of the Spirit in Pentecost.


